

LOCAL RULES

THE RULES OF GOLF EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1ST 2012 AND THE DECISIONS ON THE RULES OF GOLF 2012-2013 AS APPROVED BY THE R & A RULES LIMITED WILL APPLY. LOCAL RULES CONSISTENT WITH THE POLICY SET FORTH IN APPENDIX I OF THE RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS.

- 1) **BOUNDARIES** – THE BOUNDARIES OF THE COURSE ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:
 - a) ALL FENCES AND BOUNDARY WALLS MARKED WITH WHITE PAINT.
- 2) **OUT OF BOUNDS** – ALL AREAS BEYOND THE COURSE BOUNDARIES AS DEFINED ABOVE.
- 3) **FAIRWAYS** – FAIRWAY IS DEFINED BY THE CLOSELY MOWN AREA BETWEEN THE 1ST CUT ON EITHER SIDE.
- 4) **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** – A PLAYER MAY OBTAIN RELIEF FROM INTERFERENCE AS DEFINED IN RULE 24-2A FROM THE FOLLOWING, IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED UNDER RULE 24-2B –
 - a) EXCRETA.
 - b) FENCING WITHIN THE COURSE EXCLUDING THOSE DEFINING BOUNDARIES.
 - c) THE 5TH GENTS TEE BOX GUARD
 - d) ALL TREE GUARDS, PLANTS PROTECTED BY WHITE STICKS, SPRINKLERS, ROTORS, HYDRANTS, CONTROL VALVES, PERMANENT YARDAGE MARKERS`
 - e) ALL FLOWER BEDS /NURSERY AND TREE /SAPLING GUARDS-RELIEF MANDATORY.
 - f) BRIDGES RIGHT OF FAIRWAY 11
 - g) OLD KITCHEN HUT AND ADMIN OFFICE RIGHT OF 8TH FAIRWAY
 - h) NET & POSTS LEFT OF 14TH FAIRWAY AND 10TH TEE BOX.
- 5) **INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**
 - a) STARTERS HUT RIGHT OF TEE BOX NO.1.
 - b) PUMP HOUSE RIGHT OF 6TH & 7TH HOLE
 - c) SHELTER BEHIND 5TH GREEN
 - d) SHELTER BEHIND 12TH GREEN
 - e) PUMP HOUSE LEFT OF 1ST FAIRWAY
 - f) BRIDGE CONNECTING 8TH TEE TO GREEN
 - g) ENTIRE ICL HUT AREA
- 6) **WATER HAZARDS** – WATER HAZARDS (WH) ARE DEFINED BY YELLOW PAINT/STAKES AND LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (LWH) ARE DEFINED BY RED PAINT/STAKES. A BALL IN OR LOST IN SUCH HAZARDS MAY BE PLAYED IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES 26-1 AND 26-2
- 7) **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** –ANY G.U.R. WILL BE MARKED BY WHITE STAKES OR LINES. RELIEF MAY BE TAKEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 25-1B.
- 8) **AERATION HOLES** – ON THE PUTTING GREEN, A BALL WHICH COMES TO REST IN OR ON AN AERATION HOLE MAY BE LIFTED WITHOUT PENALTY, CLEANED AND PLACED AS NEAR AS POSSIBLE TO THE SPOT WHERE IT LAY BUT NOT NEARER THE HOLE AND WHICH MAY BE OFF THE GREEN.
- 9) **BALL STRIKING FENCING ACROSS THE ROAD AND OVERHEAD WIRE/CABLE** – A BALL IN THE COURSE OF ITS CARRY, DIRECTLY STRIKING THE FENCING LOCATED OR CONSTRUCTED WITHIN THE COURSE BOUNDARY AND ANY OVERHEAD WIRE OF CABLE MUST BE REPLAYED BY DROPPING THE BALL AT A SPOT AS NEARLY AS POSSIBLE TO THE SPOT FROM WHICH THE BALL WAS LAST PLAYED. (RULE 20-5.)
- 10) **FREE LIFT ZONE** – WHEN A BALL IN PLAY, LIES IN THE FREE LIFT ZONES (MARKED BY BLUE STONES) RUNNING PARALLEL TO THE ROADS AND ON THE ROADS CUTTING ACROSS THE 9TH, 15TH, 16TH AND 18TH HOLES, IT MAY BE LIFTED AND DROPPED WITHOUT PENALTY, NOT NEARER THE HOLE, AT ANY POINT ON THE PERPENDICULAR LINE JOINING THE CORRESPONDING FENCE AND THE LINE JOINING THE BLUE STONES.
A BALL IN PLAY WHICH LIES ON THE ROAD RIGHT AND LEFT OF THE 18TH GREEN, WITHIN THE LINE JOINING THE BLUE MARKERS PAINTED ON THE CHAIN LINK FENCE AND THE OUT OF BOUNDS WALL, MAY BE LIFTED AND DROPPED WITHOUT PENALTY IN THE NEAREST DROP ZONE MARKED ON THE RIGHT AND LEFT SIDES OF THE 18TH FAIRWAY, EVEN IF SUCH A DROP ZONE IS CLOSER TO THE HOLE THAN WHERE THE BALL ORIGINALLY LAY.
- 11) **INTERVENTION (LINE OF SIGHT) RELIEF FOR PLAY OF THE 3RD HOLE ONLY**, IF THE FENCE/NET GUARDING THE 7TH TEE, 6TH GREEN AND 5TH MEN'S TEE BOX INTERVENES DIRECTLY BETWEEN THE PLAYERS BALL AND THE 3RD HOLE, RELIEF MAY BE OBTAINED BY DROPPING THE BALL MORE THAN ONE CLUB LENGTH BUT LESS THAN TWO CLUB LENGTHS FROM THE NEAREST EDGE TO WHERE THE BALL LIES.
AS AN ADDITIONAL OPTION, THE PLAYER MAY DROP WITHOUT PENALTY IN THE NEAREST DROP ZONE, EVEN IF SUCH A DROP ZONE IS CLOSER TO THE HOLE THAN WHERE THE BALL ORIGINALLY LAY.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

MATCH PLAY : LOSS OF HOLE
STROKE PLAY : 2 STROKES.

PLAY FAST, REPAIR DIVOTS, BALL-MARKS & DAMAGE BY SPIKES, RAKE BUNKERS
