

Pace and Order of Play
(Extracted from TNGF Golf handbook and R&A guidelines)

Play at Good Pace and Keep Up. Please play in the spirit of the game. The overriding principle is that consideration should be shown to others on the course at all times and safety guidelines followed.

If a group loses a clear hole and is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind for a pass irrespective of the number of players in that group. Also if it is apparent you are holding up the group behind, invite them for a pass irrespective of the number of players in that group.

All 3 pars are “call through“ holes. Once your group is on the green you must ask the group behind to tee off before you start putting (or even if you have started putting).

On common fairways, higher hole has priority: 18 over 1, 7 over 2, 11 over 10.

A golf game shall not commence on any other hole other than the 1st and 9th unless permitted by the Committee.

Time charts are only indicative and the guidelines herein are over riding.

WEEKDAYS

Any group playing a full round has priority over a group playing a shorter round irrespective of the number of players in that group.

2 ball has priority over 3 and 4 ball and 3 ball over 4 ball. Single ball has no priority.

Flights with 5/6/7 balls are permitted on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9th tee box only. However tee time is restricted from 12.15 p.m. to 12.35 p.m. with a maximum of 3 slots and they do not have any priority. On these two days 9th tee box is closed for other afternoon golfers until 1.30 p.m. and the 1st tee box between 3.15 p.m. to 4.15 p.m.

Any group playing a round in the correct order of holes (irrespective of the number of players in that group) has priority over a group not playing in the correct order.

Cutting in is allowed only when one hole behind and hole in front is clear.

Groups which have started on the 1st or 9th hole and have completed playing the 8th and 16th holes respectively in serial order can continue playing without a break.

WEEKENDS AND DESIGNATED HOLIDAYS

4 ball, 3 ball and 2 ball have equal standing. Single ball is not allowed.

Cutting in is not allowed.

Groups which have started on the 1st or 9th hole must play in serial order and have to compulsorily take a break after the 8th and 16th hole respectively.

In the event of bunching of groups on the 17th tee box, groups starting on the 1st will alternate with groups starting on the 9th.

A copy of TNGF handbook will be kept at starter shacks on 1st and 9th and with the marshals.
